Notice of Community Meetings On Timber Royalties Ratification

Please be advised that citizens are strongly encourage to attend public meetings to receive information on a global without prejudice offer made by Canada on GBFN's Timber Royalties Specific Claim. At these meetings, members be advised as to how they can fully participate in the ratification process.

These sessions, held both in and outside GBFN, will be facilitated by Chief King and will include presentations from GBFN Negotiation Team, an independent financial advisor and our community's legal counsel on this claim.

The dates of the community consultation meetings are; for members residing outside of GBFN: in Thunder Bay on **Wednesday**, **Augusth 24**th at the Valhalla Inn from 6:30 – 8:30 P.M. and for members residing in GBFN: in GBFN on **Thursday**, **August 25**th at the GBFN Recreation Centre from 9:30 – 11:30 A.M. Due to the confidential nature of the information being provided, GBFN members will be required to show their Status Card to gain entry to the meetings.

The Ratification Officer will also be attending the Thunder Bay meeting to assist offreserve members with questions surrounding their mail-in balot packages that they will be receiving by mail at their homes. Members are encouraged to bring these packages with them to the meeting.

Looking forward to seeing all Citizens at these sessions to disclose the offer details and discuss the necessary actions – by Council and Members – to moving forward in a positive way.
